Roots&Routes was founded in the Netherlands in 2001. After having organised R&R projects all over the Netherlands, in 2004 the Dutch Roots&Routes Foundation and Mira Media successfully exported the concept to likeminded organisations around Europe. After various transnational projects the Roots&Routes International Association was founded in 2008.

Spread in 11 European countries the scope of our members reaches from the field of performing arts, such as contemporary and urban music and dance, to visual arts and multimedia, such as video journalism, editing, moderation and live VJing: next others the worldwide known "Sziget Festival" in Budapest and the "Fabbrica Europa Festival" in Florence belong as well to R&R INT as the "Interactive Media Lab" of the University of Barcelona, the media education centre "jfc" in Cologne or the culture development association "RIF" in Lille.
